My 2023 Proposed Legislation

HB 1109

Substitution of Work Experience for Postsecondary Education Requirements

- Allows public employers to substitute workforce experience in lieu of a postsecondary degree.
- Removes barriers for Floridians trying to make a better living for their families.

HB 621

Death Benefits for Active Duty Servicemembers

- Revises the benefit to survivors of first responders and military members
- Allows Department of Military Affairs to make rules regarding the servicemember's written declaration to their service branch.

HB 737

Secondhand Goods

- Levels the playing field for locally owned Florida-based Bullion dealers.
- Clarifies and makes consistent that all forms of Bullion are treated equally.
- Will allow Florida sellers to obtain more competitive pricing for their Bullion.

HB 1111

Value-added Insurance Products

- Provides that certain restrictions against unfair discrimination & unlawful rebates do not include value-added products & services offered & provided by insurers & agents if certain conditions are met.
- Provides requirements for & restrictions on insurers & agents offering & providing such products & services.

More of my proposed legislation

HB 305

Protection of Medical Freedom

- Amends Current OPT-OUT Tracking System in State Law
- Amends Current Vaccine Passport Ban in State Law
- Prohibits workforce discrimination on the basis of vaccine and immunization status.

HB 1593

Florida Public Commission Rules

- Provides that certain rules adopted by Florida Public Service Commission are not subject to rulemaking requirements relating to statements of estimated regulatory costs.

HB 253

Regulation of Securities

- Provides a framework that facilitates local investment deals with the goal of growing the economies of our local communities.
- Modernizes and amends Florida's securities regulation statute to remove regulatory burdens that prevent Floridians from obtaining investment capital

HR 8017

Alzheimer's and Brain Awareness

- Designates June 2023 as "Alzheimer's and Brain Awareness Month" in Florida.

HR 8025

Kidney Disease Awareness Month and World Kidney Day

- Recognizes March 2023, as "Kidney Disease Awareness Month" & March 9, 2023, as "World Kidney Day" in Florida
