**Florida House Passes
Legislation to Modernize Florida's
Retirement System**

Tallahassee, FL- The Florida House today passed CS/HB 7107, which modernizes the Florida Retirement System.

"The Florida House is strongly committed to protecting the Florida Retirement System for our retirees and giving our state employees retirement options that best fit their needs," said House Speaker Steve Crisafulli (R-Merritt Island). "Chair Caldwell's bill increases portability options for employees in the Florida Retirement System, decreases risks borne by taxpayers, and protects the families of our brave law enforcement officers who are killed in the line of duty."

"The House's plan to modernize the FRS better reflects today's mobile workforce, who will benefit more from the flexible and portable Investment Plan," said House State Affairs Committee Chairman Matt Caldwell (R-North Fort Myers).
