Provide for removal and disposal of sediment/silt that has accumulated in the Coghatchee River and is creating a significant impediment to stormwater conveyance, specifically east and west of the US 41 Coghatchee River bridge. This waterway receives regional stormwater flows from both Collier County and areas from the north, including Bonita Springs and Estero in Lee County, areas that were significantly impacted by flooding in 2017, pre and post Hurricane Irma.
