The project has two specific goals: (1)Reduce response times: Current 911-call response times in this area are six minutes and 59 seconds. Construction of the new fire station should reduce response times in this community (Tamarac/neighborhood cities/Broward County) to that of the rest of the City at approximately five minutes, 36 seconds (2) Provide a Field Operations Center during emergency events such as hurricanes or acts of terror.
